Indenture made the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August in the year 1830 between William Griffen and Virgin  
as his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Marmaduke St. Branch his  
husband the other party that the said William Griffen and Virginina his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one  
hundred and fifty Dollars and  
cents to him in hand paid by the said Marmaduke St. Branch also before  
the making and delivery of the indenture the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have agreed and doth bind  
by these presents to bargan and sell unto the said Marmaduke St. Branch his heirs and assigns a certain  
tract of land containing by a late Survey One hundred thirty two acres and two hundred thirty three and a half  
pole more or less lying and situated in the County of Southampton being a part of what is termed the  
Adam's tract and bounded as follows Beginning at a tree a corner between William Griffen Branch  
Branch and the Ralls tract and running N 28° 30' E. 2. 48 poles thence N 11° 17' 28 poles thence S 30° 42' 23

incomes and profits thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of land with all and singular the appurtenances  
unto the said Marmaduke St. Branch his heirs and assigns forever. And the said William Griffen and Virginina his  
wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract of land with all and singular the appurtenances  
unto the said Marmaduke St. Branch his heirs and assigns from the  
Claim or claims of them the said William Griffen and Virginina his wife or either of them or  
either of them and of all and every person & persons whatsoever heire or devise and to maner and  
form defend by these presents. In witness whereof the said William Griffen and Virginina his
