 This Indenture made this 7th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and thirty four in Benjamin Whitfield of the one part and Edm^d Beale of the other part both of the County of
 Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Whitfield for and on consideration
 of the sum of Two hundred dollars to him hereunto paid by the said Edm^d Beale the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged the said Benjamin Whitfield hath granted conveyed and sold and aliened
 enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth give, bargain sell enfeoff and confirm unto the
 said Edm^d Beale his heirs and assigns forever one certain parcel or tract of land containing by estima-
 tion one hundred acres be the same more or less situated lying and being in the County of Southampton &
 Parish of Saint Luke's and bounded as follows on the East by the land of Joseph Pope dec^d on the South
 by the lands of Samuel Boone on the west by the said Benjamin Whitfield's land called the Poppy
 track on the west by the land of said Edm^d Beale and on the North by the land of Manuka Drake
 & being the same tract conveyed to said Benjamin Whitfield by a deed from his father Nathaniel White-
 field. To have and to hold the above said tract of land and premises and every parcel thereof
 and also the reversion and accretions and remainments rights titles interests claim and demand where-
 ever of them the said Benjamin Whitfield as aforesaid or any other person or persons claiming under
 him or in and to the said premises all and singular the said land above mentioned unto the said
 Edm^d Beale for himself and his heirs the said tract of land, and every part thereof against them-
 selves their heirs and assigns and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever to the said Edm^d Beale
