This Indenture made and entered into this 26th day of July one thousand Eight hundred and thirty six between
Dixon Carver of the first part William E. Lawrence of the second and Thomas Lawrence of the third part all
of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witness that whereas the said Dixon Carver law-
fully and lawfully sold unto William E. Lawrence in the first and full sum of fifty two dollars lawful money
of Virginia which was a promissory note bearing date with these presents and made payable from the
date thereof. Bore the said Dixon Carver being desirous to indemnify and secure the payment of the
above sold. Was more especially for the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by him the said Thomas
Lawrence before the entering and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledged
Altho that he the said Dixon Carver hath granted bargain and sold and doth by these presents
grant bargain and sell to him the said Thomas Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever one
certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County and State containing one hun-
dred and two acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Matthew Daughtry Joseph Davidson
