of the aforesaid County and also my stock of horses cattle and hogs my farming utensils of all kinds my
household and Kitchen furniture To him the said Thomas Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever
upon the following trust & c't that if the said David Gardner shall fail to pay and discharge
the above mentioned debt and all costs pertaining to this Trust it shall be lawful and right on the
part for him the said Thomas Lawrence to demand as requests in writing from him the said William
E Lawrence his heirs and assigns to set up and sell for cash the above land and property &c
named after giving public Notice by advertisement to be set up at different places in the neighborhood
of the above land and property at least twenty days before the day of sale and entitle the money so
raised fully pay off the above debt and all costs pertaining to this Trust and the surplus of any
pay over to him the said David Gardner his heirs or assigns. In Testimony whereof we the parties

The Indenture made the 1st day of March 1830 Between James Cooper of the County of Gloucester
of the first part Robert Key of the County of Suffolk of the second part and Alexander T Lane of the
said County of Suffolk of the third part witnesseth that whereas the said Alexander T Lane having
been as security for the said James Cooper to a Bond executed to Alexander P. Pick a citizen of New
York &c and bearing date the 22nd day of December 1828 for the sum of two hundred and ten dollars
and interest for the further appearance of the said payment it is agreed by the parties hereto that a
conveyance in Trust shall be made to the said Robert Key for the benefit of the said Alexander T
Lane in case the said sum of two hundred and ten dollars shall remain unpaid with interest
interest from the date due of the same vizt. In Testimony Whereof that the said James Cooper from
in consideration of the promised and to the further sum of one dollar to him the said James Cooper
in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has granted bargained and sold and by these presents
do grant bargained and sold unto the said Robert Key his heirs or assigns the following property to wit to say
vizt namely Parker and Matthew and one black mare To have and to hold unto the said Robert Key
his heirs and assigns in Trust forever and it is hereby declared to be the true intent and meaning of these
present that the said James Cooper shall punctually pay to the said Alexander P. Pick a/c of
his heirs or assigns the said sum of two hundred and ten dollars and interest then the said Robert
Key his heirs or assigns shall hold the said Negroes and Mare above granted to the said Alexander
and Robert of him the said Robert Key and the said Robert Key covenants and agrees with the said
that in case the said James Cooper his heirs Executors administrators or assigns shall fail to make payment
unto the said Alexander P. Pick a/c then the said Robert Key his heirs or assigns on a day before
the 25th day of December 1830 the sum due on the said Bond aforesaid that the above Robert Key
his heirs or assigns shall stand bound of the above grants and bargains for property aforesaid forthwith
to sell the same following trust That at the request of the said Alexander T Lane his heirs or assigns
he the said Robert Key his heirs or assigns or either of them shall after giving ten days notice
at least shall at public sale sell the above mentioned property or so much thereof as may be left
over to discharge the said Debt and interest or so much thereof as may be due together with
all the expenses remaining or arising from the said Notice and sale with the necessary charges
and shall pay the money arising therefrom to the said Alexander T Lane his heirs or assigns
so far forth as shall then be due and after discharging the costs shall pay the sum last money
