Madison held and firmly binds unto the President and Directors of the Strange Fund and their heirs, assigns, executors, administrators, the past and full sum of Two thousand Dollars to which payment said and only to be made to the said President and Directors of the Strange Fund and their executors in Office as Executors and Administrators jointly and severally, by these presents, under seal and date this 15th day of November 1830. The Condition of the above obligation is such that when the above said Elias Summerville, Abel Jackson and John W. Madison on the 15th day of November 1830 by the Court Commissioners in and for the County of Southampton appointed their Treasurer, for the year ending on the 31st of December 1830, one of the said Elias Summerville shall faithfully apply and account for all monies which may come to his hands by virtue of this Office and shall do perform and execute all and every act and thing appertaining to his said Office according to Law then the above obligation to be void in effect to remain in full force and virtue.

This Indenture made this 27th day of September in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and thirty between Hyszekiah Bradshaw and Leticia his wife Johnson Pope and John Click of the one part and Henry Harris of the other part all of the County of Southampton Parish of New York and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Hyszekiah Bradshaw and Leticia his wife Johnson Pope and John Click for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred & twenty dollars lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Henry Harris at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Hyszekiah Bradshaw and Leticia his wife Johnson Pope and John Click doth hereby acknowledge have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Henry Harris his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the Parish and County aforesaid containing by estimation ninty seven acres be the same more or less lying on the North line of Black Creek and bounded as follows Beginning at a Lightwood post a corner of Lawrence Snyder and the McCrell Land to called thence by the 12th pole to a maple in Black Creek thence the same course of said Creek downwards to a ^{a corner} ~~corner~~ Matthew Bull's line thence along the said Bull's line leaving said Creek at 13th to a pine a corner thence at 8th to a run ^{line} ~~line~~ of marked trees to the Beginning. It being a part Lawrence Snyder's dec^d tract of Land sold under a decree of the Court with all the houses out houses ells & water courses profits commodities and appurtenances whatso ever to the said land belonging or in any wise appertaining to the same or any part or parcel thereof to have and to hold the said 97 acres of Land with all & singular the premises herebefore mentioned or intended to be sold with every of their right members and appurtenances unto the said Henry Harris his heirs and assigns forever And the said Hyszekiah Bradshaw and Leticia his wife Johnson Pope and John Click for themselves and their heirs the said 97 acres of Land unto the said Henry Harris his heirs and
