are to Ann Booth by Note amounting to thirty five dollars and 34 cents bearing
date the tenth day of September one thousand Eight hundred and thirty and in
consideration sum of one dollar in hand paid to him the said Littlebury Jones by the
said Colbury Booth before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt

sold and by these presents doth grant bargains and sell unto the said Colbury
