lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by estimation
one hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of James E.
Peters John Myricks Estate Sarah Kersome and others abutting thereon and bounded
by the said Peters of J. Kersome and by him of Richard Barrow adjoins
from reference to deeds of record in the said County of Southampton to have
and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and the premises aforesaid
with all their rights and profits which shall appertain unto the said Edwin
Pittman his heirs Executors administrators and Assigns forever And the said P. P.
Pittman and Mary Pittman for themselves and their heirs shall well and
quietly and forever defend all right title claim or demand of them the said
P. P. Pittman and Mary Pittman or their heirs to the said land or of every or
any other person whatsoever unto them the said Edwin Pittman and his heirs or
