This Indenture made this Eighth day of September 1830 Between Alexander
Pete and Mary E his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and
Edwin Pittway of the other part Witnesseth that the said Alex P Pete and Mary
E his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars current
money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Edwin Pittway the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged that the said Alex P Pete and Mary E his wife have
bargained granted and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto
the said Edwin Pittway his heirs and assigns forever one tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by estimation
one hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded by the land of James C
Peters John Myricks Estate Sarah Newsum and others it being the land parcelled
by the said Pete of S Newsum and by him of Richard Barror as well as ap-
pear from reference to deeds of record in this said County of Southampton To have
and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and the premises aforesaid
with all their rights and profits with its appurtenances unto the said Edwin
Pittway his heirs Executors admors and assigns forever And do the said Alex
Pete and Mary E his wife for themselves and their heirs shall sell and
do warrant and forever defend all right title claim or demand of them the said
Alex P Pete and Mary E his wife or their heirs to the said land or of every or
any other person whatsoever unto him the said Edwin Pittway and his heirs or
assigns forever In Witness whereof we Alex P Pete and Mary E his wife
have hereunto set their hands and seals this day and year above written
