I MORN^t. all men by these presents that I. Blandy Craft of the County of Southampton in the State of New York for and in consideration of the mutual love and affection which I bear to my son John T. Craft of the County of Southampton of this State aforesaid as well as for the further consecration of one dollar to me remaining paid by the said John T. Craft at or before the concluding and delivery of these presents do receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge. I the said Blandy Craft having given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John T. Craft his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land called and known by the name of Littleton which I purchased from Richard Clurke a certaine small tract which I purchased from Mathew and William Foster and which adjoins the said Littleton tract which Conveyance may be seen refering hereunto to the records of Southampton County aforesaid containing two hundred and fifty acres more or less. Bounding on the East by Blackwater River on the South by the lands of Ann Gardner. James Gardner. Steven Holland and many Holland on the West by the lands of Edward Crumpler and on the North by the lands of Mathew Foster and Rhoda McCleary the river and river side remainder and reminders yearly and other rents annuall and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof. also the following negro slaves namely Dave Anthony. Miles. Warren. Joe. Argyl. Rose. Pat. Kid. Patimus. Amy. Takemy. Any. Priscilla. Lila. Stella. Eppideens. Cherry. Chloe and Dame also six horses one flock of over Twenty hens of Cattle forty five head of Sheep. Twenty five head of hogs and ten Hwang. Stills. To have and to hold the said lands with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned and the aforesaid slaves and their future increase and the personal estate herein before mentioned unto him the said John T. Craft his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever. And the said Blandy Craft for himself and his heirs executors administrators and assigns the said tract or parcels of Land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned and the said lands and their future increase aforementioned and the personal estate aforesaid unto the said John T. Craft his heirs. Executors administrators and assigns against the claim of him the said Blandy Craft his heirs Executors administrators and against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall will and do cleare and forward defend them by these presents In witness whereof the said Blandy Craft hath hereunto set his hand and seal the first day of July 1830.
