that the said Jesse Landford as aforesaid trustee for and in behalf of the said
Lazar Bonner and being thereunto required that agreeable to the said Trust which
for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred dollars to him in hand
paid by the said Elijah Syner the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
by the said Jesse Landford, the said Jesse Landford hath sold according
to the provision of the said Trust and granted unto the said Elijah Syner to him
and his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land and premises situate
the said County Syner near County. Shale near his is situated and by map in
the County and state aforesaid containing by estimation seventy five acres
or the same more or less which land the said County Syner or his heirs
purchased of his brother Jonathan Syner and bounded as follows Beginning
at a small Cypress standing on the West side of Black Traer River thence down
said River to the mouth of Back River thence down said Back River to the
mouth of Sacks branch thence up said Branch to a maple standing near the
run of said Branch thence along a line of marked trees across the high Land
and Islands to the first Station to which such all and singular the premises
thence belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said trust or parcel of Land
and premises To have and to hold the said Land with all its profits and em-
uments unto the said Elijah Syner to him and his heirs forever and the said
Jesse Landford will for himself and his heirs forever warrant and defend the

Child Moriah Boy Jacob and Clarke unto them the said Benjamin C.
Waller and Joseph T. Claib their Executors administrators and assigns
forever and the said Saml P. Claib for myself my Executors and administra-
