Know all men these Indenture made this 4th day of December in the year one thousand Eight hundred and thirty Between Arent Hamis and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and John T Barron of the other part all of the County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke's Wm of the 1st that the said Arent Hamis and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of ten hundred and sixteen dollars to them in hand paid on or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Arent Hamis and Elizabeth his wife doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold alone and confirmed unto the said John T Barron and to his heirs and assigns forever all that tract of Land which I purchased of Charles W Goodrye and wife containing one hundred and fifty four and five the same more or less bounded as follows by the said John T Barron Elizabeth Barron's de'd Land and Arent Hamis's line To have and to hold the said one hundred and fifty four and five Land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said John T Barron his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said John T Barron his heirs and assigns forever And the said Arent Hamis and Elizabeth his wife doth for themselves and their heirs covenant and agree with the said John T Barron his heirs and assigns that so the said Arent Hamis and Elizabeth his wife their heirs Executors administrators and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend the title to the above mentioned Land and premises unto the said John T Barron and unto his wife their heirs and assigns forever against the claims or claims of all persons whatever In Witness whereof we the said Arent Hamis and Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and date first above written
