She the said Elizabeth Harris acknowledged that she saw the said Deed and declared that she had willingly signed said Deed and delivered the same and that she wished not to retract it. Given under our Hands and Seals this 4 day of December 1830.

This Indenture made this 18 day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty between John Thomas Cannon and Mary This wife of the one part and Stuart Harris of the other part all of the County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke. Witnesseth that the said John T. Cannon and Mary This wife for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred Dollars to them in hand paid in or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof we the said John T. Cannon and Mary This wife do hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold aliened and confirmed unto the said Stuart Harris and to his heirs and assigns forever all the proportion of the tract of Land which was assigned as dower to Elizabeth Cannon widow of the late Henry Cannon dec'd nor the wife of the said Stuart Harris and to which said wife's title as one of the distributees of the said Henry Cannon being one fourth part thereof and also one other fourth part to which my brother Richard Cannon was entitled and also one other fourth part to which my brother Henry Cannon was entitled and by reference to the Deeds from my said Brothers conveying their said proportions of the said tract of Land to me the said John T. Cannon the same will more fully appear and confirming by estimation in the whole Dower from him and acres thereunto of which I do hereby certify to be conveyed by us the said John T. Cannon and Mary This wife to the said Stuart Harris and to his heirs and assigns in reversion after the death of this said wife is determined To have and to hold the said three fourths of the said tract unto John T. Cannon and Mary This wife Richard Cannon of the said Cannon's conveying aunts with all and singl[ar] the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Stuart Harris his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Stuart Harris his heirs and assigns forever and the said John T. Cannon and Mary This wife do hereby themselves and their heirs covenant and agree with the said Stuart Harris his heirs and assigns that they the said John T. Cannon and Mary This wife their heirs Executors and assigns shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend the reversionary right in the above mentioned Land and premises unto the said Stuart Harris his heirs and assigns forever.
