This Indenture made the 20th day of November in the year of our Lord 1820
one thousand eight hundred and twenty between Matthew Soyner and Elizabeth his
wife of the one part and John Camp of the other part all of the County of Southampton
and Parish of a totteray Wotton parish that the said Matthew Soyner and Elizabeth his
wife in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty Dollars of lawful money of
Virginia to them in hand paid by the said John Camp at or before the end along and
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained
and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said John Camp his heirs
and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County and
Parish aforesaid Containing by estimation Eighty five and one half acres more or
less and bounded on the north by Black Creek on the east by the Land of
Mary Morrell on the South by the Land of Joseph Morris and Ely Soyner and on
the west by the Land of Jeremiah Soyner reference being had to a more fully
appears together with all and singular the houses out houses edifices buildings
yards gardens or chard ways water and water courses with all the privileges
and emoluments whatsoever to the said Land belonging or in anywise appertaining
to the same or any part or parcel thereof To have and to hold the said 85 1/2
acres of Land with the tenements and singular the premises before mentioned
and every part and parcel thereof unto the said John Camp his heirs and assigns
forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said John Camp his
heirs and assigns forever and the said Elizabeth Soyner and Elizabeth herself
for themselves and their heirs with all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said John Camp his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claim
of the said Matthew Soyner & Elizabeth his wife or either of them and of all
and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will demand and forever
defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said Matthew Soyner and
Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day
and year above written
