Gurley of the second part and Amos Stephenson of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Whereas the said Bernell Edwards is justly indebted to the said Amos Stephenson by note payable the 24th December 1830 for the sum of sixty dollars which debt with the interest thereon accruing the said Bernell Edwards is willing and desirous to secure to the said Amos Stephenson. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and also for the further consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said John M. Gurley at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents give grant bargain and sell unto the said John M. Gurley a certain tract or parcel of Land containing seventy seven acres to the same more or less adjoining the Lands of Wicher Wick Henry Blon and others do well see and
