the year 1830 Between Samuel Kelle and Mary A R his wife of the County of Southampton State aforesaid of the one part and D L C Fitzgerald of the same of the other part Witnesses: That the said Samuel Kelle and Mary his wife in and execution of fifty dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said D L C Fitzgerald at or before the entering and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold in full and entire present do bargain and sell each and both of them unto the said D L C Fitzgerald his heirs and assigns a certain interest in a parcel of Land situate and lying immediately in the Town of Jerusalem extending from a line running east and West and being the division line between Land owned by James Kelle and this said parcel Northwardly to a line running in same direction and being the division line between Land owned by Robert Goodwin Ege and this same parcel thence the Northern and Southern bound and to the east it is also bounded by being owned by the said Robert Goodwin Ege and on the west by the Lots of the Town of Jerusalem (the other parties interested in this Land do suppose to be in all ten acres or the less of Henry Gentry dec'd) together with all and singular the appurtenances and the revenues and revenues remainder and remainders openly and other rents issues and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold all the said Interest with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said D L C Fitzgerald his heirs and assigns forever And the said Samuel Kelle and Mary his wife for themselves and their heirs the said interest in the aforesaid parcel of Town Acres of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances also aforesaid mentioned unto the said D L C Fitzgerald his heirs and assigns forever from the claim or claim of them the said Samuel Kelle and Mary his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons what soever shall write and do against and forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said Samuel Kelle and Mary his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
