This Indenture made the twelfth day of January Eighteen Hundred and thirty between L. C. Freewant and his wife Maria D. of the County of Southampton of the one part and Henry B. Vaughan of the same County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said L. C. Freewant and Maria D. his wife in consideration of Twenty five dollars of lawful money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Henry B. Vaughan at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold unto the said Henry B. Vaughan his heirs and assigns all their interest in that piece of Land described in and conveyed by Deed from Samuel Pellet to the said L. C. Freewant therein conveyed except so much as lies immediately behind this lot running back just over the branch and as well as from his Northern to his Southern fence supposed to be a little over one acre To Have and to Hold the said Land with the Tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises therein before described and intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of them rights members and appurtenances unto the said Henry B. Vaughan his heirs and assigns forever And the said L. C. Freewant and Maria D. his wife or either of them their or either of them heirs and assigns and every person or persons whatsoever shall and is so warrant and defend
