 parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing one hundred
 fifty one and 1/2 acres and bounded by the lands of the said Nathan Pope William
 Pope Jr. Henry Pope also a new line dividing the land of Henry Pope and the
 Nathan Pope running N 45° E to a Glob a Corner thence a new line between said
 parcel of Land and William H. Nicholson's land running at 45° E to a Glob a
 in a Branch thence at 30° E to a Glob a Corner also on the North by the land of
 Robert Nicholson Jr. together with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto
