This Indenture made this 24 day of January 1831 between Ann Hines of South Carolina wife of Wright Hines of the one part and Orris A Brown of the County of Southampton and State aforesaid of the second part Whereas George E Hines of the first mentioned County and State by a certain Deed duly executed and recorded in the County Court of Southampton W^{ch} hath conveyed over (for purposes therein mentioned) jointly to Samuel E Hines (also of the last aforesaid County) and the said Orris A Brown all his the said George E Hines' entire proportionable interest coming to him and of the children of his father Robert Hines dec^d under the will or wills of his grand father and grand mother William Hines and Margaret Hines as by reference to said said will more fully appear And whereas it being thought that in event of Contingencies or otherwise the aforesaid proportionable Interest of the said George E Hines would by law fall or come to his mother the said Ann Hines Now this Indenture W^{ch} is made that for and in consideration of the sum as also for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid to the said Ann Hines by the said Orris A Brown the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Ann Hines by these presents hath given granted released and relinquished all the right or title which she now has or may hereafter have in the event of Contingencies to the said proportionable interest of the aforesaid George E Hines or so much thereof as will be necessary to satisfy the claim or portion of the said Orris A Brown to the said Orris A Brown his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this first day of February 1831
