This Indenture made and entered into on this 17 day of February 1830 B. and between Elisha D. White and his wife Elizabeth of the County of Stafford State of North Carolina of the one part and Jacob Barnett of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Elisha D. White and his wife Elizabeth in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Jacob Barnett at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Jacob Barnett his heirs and assigns a certain lot or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and a part of the land formerly owned by Jacob Barnett containing Eighty nine acres by late Survey as well appears by reference to the Commission Report and the division of said dec'd land it being Lot A 14 in said Report and assigned to the above named Elisha D. White in right of his wife Elizabeth together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining To have and to hold the said Lot of Land A 14 containing Eighty nine acres as aforesaid to him the said Jacob Barnett his heirs and assigns forever and the said Elisha D. White and Elizabeth his wife for themselves and their heirs the said Eighty nine acres of Land with all and singular the appurtenances and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Jacob Barnett his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Elisha D. White and Elizabeth his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall well and do demand and forever defending these presents In Witness whereof the said Elisha D. White and Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year herein first above written
