hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Clement Rochelle
at and before the making and delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof they
doth hereby acknowledge that they the said Simon Murfree and wife have
granted bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth
grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said Clement Rochelle his heirs
