This Indenture made and entered into this 29th day of October in the year of
 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty between Peter Edwards and Nancy his wife
 of the one part and Drury Wells of the second part, all of the County of Southampton and State of
 Virginia Witnesses that the said Peter Edwards and Nancy his wife for and in
 consideration of the sum of Two hundred and Eighty dollars or thereabouts paid by the said
 Wells the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted sold conveyed and sold
 and by these presents do grant bargain and sell to the said Wells a certain tract
 or parcel of Land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid adjoining the
 land of Francis Nicholson formerly Wells Alvin Waller formerly Wells Elsham
 & others and also the lands of the said Edwards and said Wells containing forty
 three acres also all the right title interest claim and demand of the late Drury Wells
 in his heirs in and to the lands and plantation whereof is his Drury Wells
 seized and possessed and which tract before mentioned together with the said right
 title claim and demand in and to the aforesaid land and plantation the said Peter
 Edwards purchased under a Trust executed by the said Drury Wells to
 Alvin Middleton as Trustee To have and to hold all the aforesaid Lands and
 premises with the appurtenances therunto belonging to them the said Drury Wells
 his heirs &c forever The right and title to which as conveyed by the said Middleton
 as Trustee to me I do hereby warrant and defend against the claim of any person or
 persons whatever In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 the day and date first above written

This Indenture made this 15th day of February 1831 between John W. Williams
 of the first part John T. Blom Jr. and Elizabeth his wife of the second part and James
 Jackson Executor of the last Will and Testament of the third part Whereas the said
 John T. Blom Jr. on the tenth day of May in the year of our Lord 1830 in order to
 secure the payment of the sum of four hundred and thirty dollars and thirty cents
 to the said J. C. Cummings did by Indenture of Trust of that date convey to the
 said John W. Williams his heirs &c that tract or parcel of Land
 wherein the said John T. Blom then resided known by the name of the Exp.
 containing twenty five acres be the same more or less and bounded by the
 Lands of Sampson & Kase & Mary & Abby and the Orphans of John Day die
