Harrell wife First Indenture made this seventh day of August in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and thirty between William Harrell and Cherry his wife of the
 one part and James Gardner of the other part all of the County of Southampton in the State
 of Virginia Witnesses that the said William Harrell and Cherry his wife
 to James Gardner for and in Consideration of the sum one hundred and twenty eight dollars and twenty five
 Cents to them in hand paid by the said James Gardner at or before the enacting
 and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the
 said William Harrell and Cherry his wife have granted bargained and sold
 and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto the said
 James Gardner his heirs and assigns a certain tract part or parcel of Land lying and
 being in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia and situated on
 Black Water River and marked and bounded as follows Beginning at a point
 a Corner of Exam Section Thence along the river bank then up said river the said
 Course thereof 42 poles to a Cypress in the River bank then out S 85 W 15 1/2 poles
 to a small Ironwood near a red oak in the late Peter Morris line thence along said
 Morris line S 10 E 11 1/2 poles to a gum a Corner in said Morris line thence N 30
 110 poles to a red oak a Corner on Exam Section aforesaid thence at 35 E 12 1/2 poles
 to the beginning containing One hundred and thirty two and an half acres more
 less the revision and revisions remainder and remainders aforesaid and other
 rights profits and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to
 hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the premises and appurtenances unto
 the said James Gardner his heirs and assigns forever And the said William
 Harrell and Cherry his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel
 of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned
 unto the said James Gardner his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claim of
 them the said William Harrell and Cherry his wife or either of them their heirs
 or of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons who at any time shall claim
 so warrant and forever defending these presents In Witness whereof the said
 William Harrell and Cherry his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals
