This Indenture made and entered into, this 5th day of February one thousand eight hundred and thirty one between John W Reese of the first part and Nathaniel W Francis of the second part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Nathaniel W Francis the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Now the said John W Reese doth grant bargain sell and convey unto Nathaniel W Francis his heirs &c one certain tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances therunto belonging lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows (to wit) on the south by the Lands of William Francis on the East by the Lands of Nathaniel Francis and Thomas Moore dec'd on the north by the lands of John W Reese dec'd and on the West by a dividing line between Henry Moore and the said Nathaniel W Francis containing by estimation four hundred and thirty acres one half of the tract of Land formerly owned by Benjamin Blount dec'd the right and title to the said Land him the said John W Reese doth warrant and defend unto the said Nathaniel W Francis his heirs and assigns free from the claim of any person whatsoever. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred and fifty dollars paid or secured to be paid unto the said John W Reese his heirs and assigns him the said John W Reese doth grant bargain and sell and convey unto the said Henry Moore his heirs &c one certain tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances therunto belonging lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows (to wit) south by the lands of William Francis and the lands belonging to the estate of Edmund Turner dec'd West by the lands of John Moore dec'd and Henry Moore now by the lands belonging to the Estate of Honble Paulborough dec'd and East by a dividing line between Nathaniel W Francis and said Henry Moore containing by estimation four hundred and thirty acres one half of the tract of Land formerly owned by Benjamin Blount dec'd the right and title to the said Land him the said John W Reese doth warrant and defend unto the said Henry Moore his heirs or assigns free from the claim of any person whatsoever.
