Harter Foster of the one part and John Womack of the other part both of the County of South-  
ampton and State of Virginia Waterpath that the said Elancy Foster for consideration of  
the premises and the further consideration of one dollar to him or her by the said  
John Womack at and before the executing and delivery of these presents doth receipt  
whereof he hereby acknowledge to have given in quantity and value and by these presents  
gives grant, bargains and sell and confirm unto the said John Womack all the rights  
titles and interests in the said Elancy Foster may at this time have or may at any  
future time be entitled to by virtue of Dower at the death of her said husband  
Harter Foster and to a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County  
of Southampton and bounded by the lands belonging to Horace Scarborough's  
est and David Ramsay Worthington Dies and Howell Harris which said Land  
was convey'd to James Foster Dsd of gift from his father Harter Foster and  
afterwards sold by the said James Foster and sold to John Womack aforesaid  
the said John Womack has his and affixes to the said Elancy Foster by  
these presents mean and forever defend all such titles of Dower in and to  
the land and premises herein set forth before named against the claim and
