This Indenture made this 27th day of January 1831 between Nancy Foster the wife of Bailey Foster of the one part and John Wormack of the other part both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Wellmepith that the said Nancy Foster for in consideration of the premises and the further consideration of one dollar to her in hand paid by the said John Wormack at and before the executing and delivery of these presents she accepts whereof as hereby acknowledged have given grants and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell and confirm unto the said John Wormack all that right title and interest she the said Nancy Foster may at this time have or may at any future time be entitled to by virtue of Dower at the death of her said husband Bailey Foster and to a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded by the lands belonging to Horrell Scarborough's late and Jacob Ramsey Norrington Ellis and Horrell Harris which said Land was conveyed to James Foster Dec'd of gift from his father Bailey Foster and after and sold by the said James Foster and wife to John Wormack and to him the said John Wormack his heirs and assigns she the said Nancy Foster do by these presents warrant and forever defend all such title of Dower in and to the land and premises hereunto named to her named against the claim and demand of her the said Nancy Foster or any other person claiming under her or the said John Wormack his heirs and assigns she the said Nancy Foster has hereunto set her hands and seal the day and date first above written Signed
