This Indenture made this 18th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty Between Benjamin Williamson of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and William A Jones of the County and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Williamson for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars lawful money of the United States hand paid by the said William A Jones the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said William A Jones his heirs Executors administrators or assigns all the right title claim or interest which I have of and to a certain tract or parcel of Land called the Clements plantation containing by estimate three hundred and thirty five acres be the same more or less also all the right title claim or interest which I have in the down Land of Jones & Jones which down the said down Jones has conveyed to the said William A Jones which by her inference to be cords of the County of Southampton will more fully cheer The above named tracts or parcels of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid and immediately on the North Side of Meherrin River and bounded as follows Viz by the Lands of Soil M. Lenore dec^d Henry Smith and Dec^d Anson dec^d and the Clements plantation containing the number of acres hereunto before mentioned and the down of the said Jones & Jones containing one hundred and forty all making four hundred and forty acres be the same more or less To have and to hold the said Bargained and sold premises which all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the only proper use and behoof of him the said William A Jones his heirs Executors administrators or assigns the right and title of the said tract or parcel of Land as far as extendeth in me I warrant and for ever defend against the right of all and every other person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day and year above written
