Witnesseth that whereas the said Bryken has built the said meeting house being willing and desirous to secure one acre of Land wherein the said house stands to the said subscribers. Now This Indenture Witnesseth that the said Peter Purcell as well for the return I have for Christianity as for the Moderation of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said John Bryken and others the receipt whereof the said Peter Purcell doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Bryken and others forever hath granted bargained and sold by these presents to the said John Bryken and others for the use of the said meeting house the said acre of Land also all the right title interest claim or demand of them the said Peter Purcell his heirs or assigns of or unto the aforesaid premises To Have and to hold the aforesaid premises with all and singular the appurtenances unto the said Bryken and others and their heirs forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Bryken and others and their heirs in Trust to and for the only proper use hereunto mentioned that is to say for the said John Bryken or any of the said Subscribers to build a house or houses on for the benefit of the Baptist Church and the said Purcell for himself and his heirs the said acre of Land above mentioned unto the said Bryken and others and their heirs against him the said Peter Purcell and against his heirs and against the claim title and demand of any person or persons whatsoever shall and will be and by these presents ever defend In Witness whereof the said Peter Purcell hath hereunto set his hand and Seal in the day and year above written Signed sealed and delivered

Howell
