 and sell unto the said Lewis W. Cobb and to his heirs and assigns forever
 that tract or parcel of Land in Southampton County aforesaid which the said
 Richard Williams his wife of Lewis Williams by Will and is of record in
 the Clerk's Office for the County Court of Southampton aforesaid containing
 by estimation one hundred and twenty one acres to the same more or left bounded
