This Indenture made and entered into this 29th day of December one thousand
Eight hundred and thirty in and between George Williams of the first part, Thomas
Lawrence of the second part and William E Lawrence of the third part all
of Southampton County and State of Virginia Wth respect that whereas the
said George Williams stands justly indebted unto the said William E
Lawrence in the just and full sum of seventy dollars lawful money of Vir-
ginia which appears by Bond bearing date with these presents which interest
from the date thereof Now the said George Williams being desirous to
in demitify and secure to him the said William E Lawrence the payment
thereof but more especially for the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid
by him the said Thomas Lawrence before the sealing and delivering
of these presents the receipt hereof is acknowledged that he the said
George Williams hath granted bargained and sold and doth by these presents
grant bargain and sell to him the said Thomas Lawrence his heirs and
assigns forever two feather Beds and furniture Chest Tabled house hold and
Kitchen furniture and all any tools of every kind to him the said Thomas
Lawrence his heirs Executors or assigns forever and he the said George Williams
doth for himself his heirs and assigns warrant and warrant for every
defend all rights titles claims interests to the before mentioned property
to him the said Thomas Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever upon the
following trust Vizt that if the said George Williams shall fail
to pay and discharge the above debt with all cost pertaining to this Trust then
it shall be lawful and right so soon as requested in writing from under the
hands of the said William E Lawrence his heirs or assigns to set up and see
to the highest bidder for Cash before mentioned property after giving notice by
advertisements at least ten days previous to the day of sale and out of the proceeds
pay the debt and costs the overplus if any pay over to the said George
Williams his heirs or assigns In Witness whereof we the parties have
