This Indenture made this 1st day of January one thousand Eight hundred and thirty one between Richard C Gray of the first part James W Beale of the second part and Henry Stender of the third part and last part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia with special that whereas the said Richard C Gray has justly indebted into the said Henry Stender in the first and full sum of one hundred and fifty dollars and whereas the said Richard C Gray is willing and desirous of securing the said Henry Stender in the above sum of one hundred and fifty dollars aforesaid further with special that the said Richard C Gray that for and in Consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said James W Beale the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold by these presents such part Bargain and sell unto the said James W Beale forever the following property to wit all my lands lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia To have and to hold the aforesaid Land to him the said James W Beale to the proper use and behoof of him the said James W Beale forever upon the special trust and Confidence with special to and for the use and purposes following that is to say the said James W Beale shall at any time hereafter whenever he shall be requested by the said Henry Stender or his heirs of the aforesaid Land at public auction so as to pay the aforesaid sum of one hundred and fifty dollars with interest and Cost that may accrue by advertising the day and place of such sales at least three public places as the said James W Beale may think proper so as to render justice to the parties at least ten days previous notice to the day of sale for ready money and out of the proceeds of such sales pay unto the said Henry Stender his heirs or assigns the full amount of the above claim together with interest and Cost of the carrying into effect of these presents and overplus of any sum or sums which the said Richard C Gray has had or assigns or will receive whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixes our seals the day and year above written
