This Indenture made and entered into this 24th day of February 1831
between James Blor of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the first
part Edgar H Parsons of the second part and Rich^d K Strong of the third part
Whereas the said James Blor is indebted to the above named Rich^d K Strong the
in the first term of seven hundred and forty Eight dollars and 57 cents due to him
of Equal date here with and is desirous to secure the payment of the same to him
from this Indenture With effect that for and in consideration of the sum
promiss and of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Strong
before the signing and delivery of these presents by the said James Blor his
heir and assigns sold and delivered and by these presents doth bargain sell and deliver
unto the said Parsons a certain tract or parcel of Land situated on the
River in Southampton County containing by a recent survey Three hundred and
more or less and bounded as follows on the North by Land belonging
to the heirs of W^m Four dec^d on the East and West by Henry Blors Land on the
South by lands belonging to Williams Hicks and Archer Hicks To Have
and to hold to his only proper use and behoof for ever upon Trust (veruth self)
that the said James Blor is to retain possession of the said tract of Land until the
1st day of January 1832 then if default be made in the payment the said Rich^d K
Strong or their heirs or assigns shall demand the said Parsons or his heirs or
assigns to take possession of the same and after duly advertising the same and place
of sale for twenty days the said Parsons or assigns as aforesaid shall sell the
said tract of Land to satisfy the debt and interest aforesaid to the highest bidder
for Cash and out of the proceeds of such sale pay first the expenses of the Trust
then the debt aforesaid with the interest which the interest which may have
accrued thereon and the balance if any pay to the said James Blor or his heirs
But if the said James Blor at any time before the said sale shall have been and
shall pay to the said Strong or his heirs or assigns the said sum of money with
the interest thereon and the costs hereof then the said Strong or assigns that
the said tract of Land shall be freely released to him the said James Blor
of this indenture and the said Blor for himself and his heirs assigns that
the said tract of Land shall be delivered up for the three persons whom
aforesaid for In Testimony whereof the said several parties have hereunto set
