This Indenture made and entered into this 21st day of February 1831 between Thomas L. Jones of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the first part Edgar H. Parsons of the second part and Seth R. Strong & Co. of the third part Whereas the said Thomas L. Jones is indebted to the above named Seth R. Strong & Co. the sum of Three hundred and seventy nine dollars and seventy Cents due by bond with legal interest and all claims which the said Strong & Co. may hereafter hold against the said Thomas L. Jones and is desirous to secure the payment of the same thereon. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the promised sum and delivery of these presents to the said Parsons before the said Jones sold and delivered and by these presents the said Thomas L. Jones hath bargained sold and delivered and by these presents the said Thomas L. Jones hath bargained sold and delivered a certain Tract of Land situated on Cottonay River in Southampton County containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less bounded as follows on the North by land owned by Thaddeus Laughan on the east by Land owned by Robert Williams on the South and West by Cottonay River also some beds and furniture To have and to hold to his only proper use and behoof forever upon Trust nevertheless that the said Thomas Jones is to retain possession of the said tract of Land Beds and furniture until the said Seth R. Strong & Co. or their executors or assigns shall direct the said Parsons or his executors or assigns to take possession of the same and duly advertising the same and place of sale for twenty days the said Parsons as Trustee as aforesaid shall sell the said lands beds and furniture or as much of said property as may be necessary to be sold to satisfy the debt and interest aforesaid to the highest bidder for Cash and out of the proceeds of such sale pay first the expenses of the Trust then the debt aforesaid with the interest which may accrue thereon and the balance if any pay to the said Thomas L. Jones or his executors but if the said Thomas L. Jones at any time before the said date shall have been made shall pay to the said Strong & Co. their dues or assigns the said sum of money with the interest thereon and the date hereof then the said Strong & Co. Covenant that the said Land beds and furniture shall be fully released to him the said Thomas L. Jones of this in Remembrance and the said Jones for himself Covenants that the said Land Beds and Furniture shall be delivered up for these purposes whenever applied for.
