

This Indenture made and entered into this 24th day of February 1831 between
 Thomas C Jones of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the first part Edgar
 Parsons of the second part and Rich R Strong Esq. of the third part Whereas the said
 Thomas C Jones is indebted to the above named Rich R Strong Esq. in the sum
 of Three hundred and twenty nine dollars and twenty Cents duly and well欠
 due him with also all claims which he said Strong Esq. may hereafter hold against
 the said Thomas C Jones and as respects to secure the payment of the same to them
 for the Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises
 and the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Parsons before the making
 and delivery of these presents by the said Thomas C Jones hath bargained
 sold and delivered and by these presents doth bargain sell and deliver unto the
 said Parsons a certain tract of Land situated on Mattaponi River in Southampton
 County containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less bounded as follows
 on the North by land owned by Thaddeus Vaughan on the east by Land owned by Robt.
 Williams on the South and West by Mattaponi River also from beds and furniture
 to have and to hold to his only proper uses and behoof forever upon Trustman-
 ship that the said Thomas C Jones is to retain possession of the said tract
 of Land beds and furniture until the said Rich R Strong Esq. or his exec-
 ad or assigns shall direct the said Parsons or his exec ad or assigns to take possession
 of the same and duly advertising the same and place of sale for twenty days the
 said Parsons as trustee as aforesaid shall sell the said lands beds and furniture
 or as much of said property as may be necessary to satisfy the debt and interest
 aforesaid to the highest bidder for cash and out of the proceeds of such sale pay
 first the expenses of the trust then the debt aforesaid with the interest wherby may
 accrue thereon and the balance if any pay to the said Thomas C Jones or his exec-
 ad or the said Thomas C Jones at any time before the said sale shall have been
 made shall pay to the said Strong Esq. then him or assigns the said sum of money
 with the interest thereon and the costs his exec ad the said Strong Esq. Covenant that
 the said Land beds and furniture shall be fully released to him the said Thomas
 C Jones of this indenture and the said Jones for himself Covenant that the
 said Land beds and furniture shall be delivered up for these purposes whenever
 applied for In Testimony whereof the said several parties have hereunto set
