Indenture made this seventh of January in the year Eighteen hundred
and thirty one between Thomas R Gray of the County of Southampton and State of
Edwards his messenger of the first part Littleton R Edwards of the County and State aforesaid of
the second part and James R Wighamart of the third part witnesseth that the
said Gray being anxious to secure the payment of the following debts to the said Wighamart
set a debt due Louis St Kever of the Town of Portsmouth for the sum of Ninety
hundred dollars with interest &c accruing thereon also a debt due James St Kever
in the County of Southampton for three hundred dollars and the Interest and costs
accruing thereon for which debts the said Wighamart is jointly liable with the said
Gray and others and further the sum of Five hundred dollars due the said Wighamart by
the said Gray to secure the payment of which aforesaid debts and in consideration of the
sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Littleton R Edwards at or before the
executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
hath granted bargains sold and delivered unto the said Edwards all the Rents money
interest right and title or any other interest which by Law doth entitle to make
any Lands in right of my mother in the County of Suffolk Southampton and New
wick or any other title or interest in said lands that to me may accrue To have
to hold the said lands hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed unto him the said
Edwards his heirs & assigns forever upon trust nevertheless that the said Edwards
whomsoever required by the said Gray or Wighamart after giving legal notice of the
time and place of sale proceed to sell the said lands or interest therein in such time
as he may be directed by said Wighamart and after paying and satisfying said
Wighamart of the debts & charges named pay over the balance if any there be to the
Gray In Wm's esp whereof the parties herunto have set their hands and seals

First Indenture made and entered into this 13th day of February Eighteen hundred
thirty one between Daniel Felts of the first part Samuel R Woodard of the second part
and Mabella Pope of the third all of the County of Southampton and State of New
York witnesseth that whereas the said Daniel Felts stands jointly in debt to the
said Mabella Pope by Recd in the sum of Eighty dollars and ninety cents having
even date with these presents and he the said Daniel Felts being willing to have
the said debt unto the said Mabella Pope hatched and in consideration of the sum of
One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Mabella Pope at or before the making
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
granted bargains and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the
said Mabella Pope his heirs & assigns the following property to wit three feather
beds and furniture two tables and two chairs eight sitting chairs one iron bed
two pots one Spider one Skillet two spit racks one pair fire tongs and three two
tubs one pail two nezzins two bread trays one meat dish one set of knives and
forks three dishes two sets of plates one set of cups and saucers one iron trivet
two trunks one Candle stand one Coffe Mill one wooden wheel & Card no
Three hours one Grid iron one Pond stone to have and to hold the aforesaid property
