This Indenture made this seventh of January in the year eighteen hundred and thirty one between Thomas R Gray of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part, Lilliston R Edwards of the County and State aforesaid of the second part and James W Wyzehant of the third part. Witnesseth that the said Gray being anxious to secure the payment of the following debts to the said Wyzehant a debt due Louis M. Steifer of the Town of Portsmouth for the sum of nineteen hundred dollars with interest &c accruing thereon also a debt due James R. H. of the County of Portsmouth for three hundred dollars and the interest and unpaid accruing thereon for which debts the said Wyzehant is jointly bound with the said Gray and others and further the sum of Five hundred dollars due the said Wyzehant by the said Gray to secure the payment of which aforesaid debts and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Lilliston R Edwards at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain sold and delivered unto the said Edwards all the his own interest right and title or any other interest which by Law he is entitled to or shall be any Lands in right of my mother in the County of Suffolk Southampton and Portsmouth or any other title or interest in said lands that to me may accrue To have and to hold the said lands hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed unto him the said Edwards his heirs & assigns forever upon Trust notwithstanding that the said Edwards whomever required by the said Gray or Wyzehant after giving legal notice of the time and place of sale procured to sell the said lands or interest therein in such time as he may be directed by said Wyzehant and after paying and satisfying said Wyzehant of the debts &c herein named pay over the balance if any there be to said Gray In Witness whereof the parties herunto have set their hands and seals this day and date first above written

This Indenture made and entered into this 13 day of February eighteen hundred and thirty one between Daniel Felts of the first part Samuel R Woodard of the second part and Welden Pope of the third all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that whereas the said Daniel Felts stands justly in debt to the said Welden Pope due by Bond in the sum of Eighty dollars and ninety Cents having given due note there presents and he the said Daniel Felts being willing to have the said debt unto the said Welden Pope satisfied for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Welden Pope at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said Welden Pope his heirs & assigns the following property to wit three pieces of Bees and furniture two tables and twelve two Chest Eight sitting chairs one iron Bed two pots one Skillet one Skillet two pot racks one pair fire tongs and three tin trunks one pair two neggins two bed tings one meal sifter one set of Pewee and forks three dishes two sets of plates one set of cups and saucers one iron fire fork two stinks one candle stand one coffee mill one wooden wheel and one Bread hoe one Bridled one hind Stone To have and to hold the aforesaid
