Middleton This Indenture made and executed this 29th day of January in the 10th year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty one Between Arthur Francis Middleton as trustee of the one part and Wm Francis of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that whereas by a certain Deed of trust bearing date the 17th day of November 1828 and executed by a certain Colonel Reese to the said Middleton as trustee for certain purposes therein particularly mentioned he the said Middleton was empowered and required and authorized to sell at public sale a certain tract of Land containing four hundred and twenty nine acres lying and being in the County of said in the count of the said Colonel Reese's refusing my listing and failing to pay the amount of the several Bonds executed by the said Colonel Reese and his heirs Nathaniel Simmons John Thorp and John Wilkes as particularly set forth and described in said Deed in trust where the said Middleton in the Clerk's Office of the County Court aforesaid and whereas the said Colonel Reese having failed and neglected to pay the aforesaid several Bonds with the accruing interest thereon according to the intention and meaning and promise aforesaid in consequence whereof and in strict conformity of the aforesaid Deed in trust he the said Middleton acting as trustee aforesaid did after giving due notice of the time and place of sale expose to sale the aforesaid tract and parcel of Land containing 429 acres upon the premises on the 19th day of January 1831.
