 hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain
 and sell unto the said Nancy Holt his heirs and assigns forever my whole &
 sole interest what I am entitled to in a certain tract or parcel of Land which
 my brother Jesse Holt did devised and bequeathed of by my and situated in the County
 of Southampton and bounded as follows by the lands of the estate of
 John Barham dec'd on the east and north on the West by the lands of Henry Day
 on the South by the lands belonging to the estate of Jesse Holt dec'd which
 will appear more fully to say the said parcel of Land was four acres of the
