in hand paid by the said James Taper the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
edged hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give
grant bargain and sell unto the said James Taper his heirs and assigns
forever One certain tract or parcel of Land Containing by estimation twenty
acres be the same more or less and bounded being and lying on the Southwest
corner where Franklow Clark formerly lived and bounded by the lands
of Jesse Crocker attorney General and the said James Taper reference being
had well more fully appear together with all and singular the appurte-
nances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the same To have
and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereto
belonging with every part and parcel thereof unto the said James Taper
his heirs and assigns forever And the said John R. Managum and Lucy
his wife for themselves their heirs Executors admors and assigns all and singular
