This Indenture made and executed this 1st day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty one Between William H Bee and Susan his wife of the one part and Henry Bryant of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said William H Bee and wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars good and lawful money to one in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Henry Bryant the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained and sold and do by these presents give grant bargain and sell make over and convey unto the said Henry Bryant one certain tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation one hundred and sixty two acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County aforesaid and bounded by the lands of Elizabeth Turner the heirs of Thomas Brown and also the lands of Henry Bee near the mill and the lands of John A. Weston and W^m Catharine Whitehead reference being had to a Deed from
