This Indenture made this 29th day of October in the year Eighteen hundred and thirty between Robert Drury acting as Trustee of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and Henry Lenox of the aforesaid County of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and twelve dollars paid to him in hand paid at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Robert Drury having previously advertised and given ten days notice of the same has bargained and sold publicly for the best price that could be obtained and by these presents does bargain and sell unto the said Henry Lenox all right title interest and claim unto in him as Trustee to the tract of Land whereon late John Latley resided and which was conveyed by him the said John Latley Dec^d of this County unto the 22^d of March 1830. to Robert Drury as Trustee for the benefit of Henry Lenox lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and forty four acres more or less and bounded as follows by the lands of Henry Bull on the North Samuel Bennett on the East Benjamin Griffin South and William Griffin and Martha Bradshaw and together with all and singular the appurtenances with the revenues and revenues remainder and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcels of Land with the Tenements hereunto and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights incidents and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Henry Lenox his heirs and assigns for ever and the said Robert Drury for himself and his heirs the said tract of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Henry Lenox his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of him the said Robert Drury or his heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall will and do consent and forever defend as Trustee by these presents.
