the said Joseph C. Smith for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred
and fifty dollars to me in hand paid at or before the entering and delivery of
these presents the receipt and payment is hereby acknowledged have granted and
gave sold, aliened and Conferred and by these presents doth grant bargain
sell alien and Convey unto the said Joseph C. Smith his heirs and assigns
one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of South
ampton and Containing by estimation five hundred and two acres more or less
and bounded by the lands of Joseph C. Smith, Meredith Holland and others abutting
the tract of Land formerly the property of Ezra Siller and sold under a decree
of the County Court of Southampton reference being had to the report of the
Commissioners filed in the Clerk's Office of this County and also the Deed from
the said Commissioners to Joseph C. Allen daughter the person and under said
decree well more fully explain the boundaries. To have and to hold the
aforesaid bargain premises to him the said Joseph C. Smith his heirs and
assigns forever together with all and singular the appurtenances profits and
concomitants to the same in any manner belonging and the said Joseph C.
Allen daughter doth for myself, my heirs Executors or administrators hereby warrant
and forever defend a good and perfect right and title to the aforesaid tract of
Land herein conveyed to him the said Joseph C. Smith his heirs and assigns
