This Indenture made this 29<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year of our Lord thousand  
six hundred and thirty between Ben Bonner and Sally his wife both of the  
County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Louisa Jones of the County  
of Gates and State of North Carolina of the other part witnesseth that the said Ben  
Bonner and Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to  
them in hand paid by the said Louisa Jones the receipt whereof the said parties  
and Sally his wife doth acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid  
thereon and bargained sold alined released and confirmed and by these presents  
doth grant bargaine and sell unto the said Louisa Jones to her and to her heirs forever  
one certain tract of land and premises situate by me and bind in the County  
of Southampton and State of Virginia aforesaid containing the tract of Land wherein  
James Jones formerly lived which land was sold and in a deed in trust received by the  
said James Jones to Peter Whiting which trust died he died the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January  
1821 and duly recorded in the County Court of Southampton and State of Virginia for  
said and in the sale aforesaid the said Ben Bonner became the purchaser by buying  
it off the hands of William & Daugerty to whom the said Land was struck off  
the day of sale which was in the month of August 1822 which land is bounded as  
follows to wit Beginning at the road leading from old Black water bridge to Swanson  
in the line that formerly divided the said Land and the lands of Henry Jones  
thence along that line across the cut tail swamp to Joshua Whiting's line thence  
along Joshua Whiting's line to the corner thence along the edge of the ocean to the  
branch called the line Branch which divides the said land from the land belong  
ing to the heirs of Joseph Ballard dec<sup>d</sup> thence up the main run of the line Branch the  
various corners thereof to the line formerly called Benjamin Blackhead line thence  
along Blackhead's line to the line formerly known by the line of Joseph Denton dec<sup>d</sup>
