This Indenture made this 29th day of December in the year of our Lord Christ one
 thousand eight hundred and thirty between Carr Brown and Sally his wife both of the
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Louisa Jones of the County
 of Gates and State of at or in the County of the other part. Whereby that the said Carr
 Brown and Sally his wife for and in full Satisfaction of the sum of six hundred dollars to
 them in hand paid by the said Louisa Jones the receipt whereof the said Carr Brown
 and Sally his wife do acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid
 hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents
 doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Louisa Jones to her and to her heirs forever
 one certain tract or parcel of Land and premises situate lying and being in the County
 of Southampton and State of Virginia aforesaid it being the tract of Land whereon
 James Jones formerly lived which land was sold and in a deed in trust executed by the
 said James Jones to Simon Mumfery which trust deed bore date the 2nd day of February
 1821 and duly recorded in the County Court of Southampton and State of Virginia aforesaid
 said and in the date aforesaid the said Carr Brown became the purchaser by deed
 it off the hands of William C Daughtery to whom the said Land was struck off
 the day of Sale which was in the month of August 1822. which land is bounded as
 follows to wit Beginning at the road leading from old Black water bridge to the
 end of the line that formerly divided the said Land and the land of Henry Jones
 thence along that line across the cut-tail swamp to Joshua Whiting's line thence
 along Joshua Whiting's line to the corner thence along the edge of the second
 branch called the line branch which divides the said land from the land known
 to the heirs of Joseph Ballard &c. thence up the main run of the line branch
 various courses thereof to the line formerly called Benjamin Black bear's land thence
 along Black bear's line to the line formerly known by the name of Joseph Dorman &c.
