 of Virginia of the first part and Joel Cook of the second part and Edward Goodrich
 of the third part the latter of the County and State aforesaid Witnesseth that the
 said Harrison Hill stands jointly and solid to the said Joel Cook the sum of eight
 three dollars and 60 cents as well more fully appears by referring to the said
 Harrison Hill's note held by the said Joel Cook bearing date the 1st day of the
 second month 1831. Now to secure the said Joel Cook the above mentioned sum
 and the growing interest thereon and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him the
 said Harrison Hill in hand paid by the said Edward Goodrich at or before the
 sealing or delivery of these presents the receipt is hereby acknowledged that goods
 bargained and sold and by these presents both bargain grant and sell to the said
 Edward Goodrich his heirs &c all my Chattel Estate namely three beds and
 furniture 1 horse 1 cart and pair of wheels 2 iron pots 1 pan 3 Shillees 2 Hams
 1 Brod 1 plough 4 Chests 4 Chairs 1 pair iron wheels and axles and has 3 bags
 &c &c also all my three makers Tools of every description and every other species of property
 To have and to hold the above mentioned property to him the said Edward Goodrich
 and to his heirs and assigns forever upon Trust nevertheless of the said Joel Cook his heirs
 or legal representatives shall have it in their power to call on the said Edward Goodrich
 at any time to sell the above mentioned property first giving ten days public notice
