This Indenture made this day of thirtieth in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one between Augustine Bishop of the first part Giles Reese of the second part and Sampson L. Reese of the third part all of the County of Gloucester Wherasthe said Augustine Bishop is justly indebted to the said Sampson L. Reese in the sum of Seventeen dollars and Sixty Cents to be paid on the 25th of December next as by a Bond bearing date the 19th day of March 1831 now fully appears which debt with the legal interest thereon amounting the said Augustine Bishop is willing and desirous to humor. At this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the promises and acts for the further consideration of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Augustine Bishop in hand paid by the said Giles Reese at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Augustine Bishop hath given granted bargained sold alured entreated released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alure entreated release and confirm to the said Giles Reese his heirs and assigns forever the following property trust 2 feather Bed and furniture one Box and Calf 3 Pew Tables 2 dozen Chairs 1 piano chest 1 hay mow 15 spening what 1/2 dozen knives and forks Cups and Saucers plates and dishes pote and pens spoons &c I have and to hold the said property to the only proper use and behoef of the said Giles Reese his heirs and assigns forever And the said Augustine Bishop for himself his heirs executors and administrators doth hereby Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Giles Reese his heirs executors and assigns forever that it is my will that the said Augustine Bishop his heirs executors and administrators the aforesaid property unto the said Giles Reese his heirs executors and assigns against persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents upon trust nevertheless that the said Giles Reese his heirs executors and administrators shall permit the said Augustine Bishop to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said property and take the profits thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment of the said sum of seventeen dollars and Sixty Cents when in the whole or in part and then upon the further trust that the said Giles Reese his heirs executors and administrators or assigns shall and will so soon after the happening of such default of payment as he the said Sampson L. Reese his heirs executors and administrators or assigns shall request sell the aforesaid property or so much thereof as shall be sufficient for the purpose shall sell at publick sale after having first given 10 days notice at some publick place by advertising the same and fixed the time and place of sale and out of the monies arising from such sale shall after satisfying the charges due and all other expenses pay to the said Sampson L. Reese his heirs executors and assigns the said sum Seventeen dollars and 60/100 with interest which may thereon lawfully have accrued and the balance if any shall pay to the said Augustine Bishop his heirs executors and administrators or assigns But if the whole of the said sum of Seventeen dollars before shall be fully paid off and discharged to the said Sampson L. Reese his heirs executors and assigns on or before the 25th day of December next when the same is payable then this Indenture to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue In witness whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
