This Indenture made the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February 1831 between Thomas Gray of the  
County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and James Rochelle of the said  
Richmond County and State of the second part and James D'Urquhart of the said County and  
State of the third part witnesseth that whereas the said Gray holds property in the  
sum of \$1000 to the said Urquhart by Bond bearing date the 21<sup>st</sup> day of February 1831 in the sum  
of Five hundred and forty six dollars and fifty seven Cents as aforesaid to said Bond  
and shall which debt with interest the said Gray is desirous to have to the said Urquhart  
March 1839 Part 1<sup>st</sup> of this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises  
and also for the further Consideration of one dollar in hand paid to the said Gray by the  
said Rochelle the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to have been paid before the  
making and delivery of these presents he the said Gray hath given granted bargained  
and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell to the said Rochelle  
his heirs or affixes forever all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the  
County of Southampton and State of Virginia known by the name of Morris' tract con-  
taining by estimation 1109 acres to the same more or less the boundaries as specified in a  
deed made by Henry Leman to the said Gray with all the appurtenances thereon and  
all the estate right title and interest of the said Gray in and to the said tract hereby granted  
or intended to be granted To have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be  
granted tract and parcel of Land and premises with all the appurtenances unto the said  
Rochelle his heirs or affixes forever to the only use and behoof of the said Rochelle his heirs  
and the said Gray for himself his heirs &c..... or affixes with hereby Covenant promising  
agree to and with the said Rochelle his heirs & forever in manner and terms following By  
the said Gray his heirs & the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises with the appurte-  
nances unto the said Rochelle his heirs & against all persons whatsoever shall and will  
warrant and forever defend by these presents upon Trust nevertheless that the said Rochelle  
wife & heirs of Rochelle  
safely Covenants so to do upon application of the said Urquhart as soon as he may wish  
to close the transaction after giving ten days public notice of the same. I will the above  
named Land to the highest bidder for Cash and out of the monies arising from said  
Sale shall after satisfying the charges thereof and all other expenses attending the  
transaction pay to the said James D'Urquhart the amount of the said Bond with interest  
and the remainder if any shall belong to the said Gray his heirs or affixes And the said  
Rochelle Covenants to recover to the said Gray the Land herein Conveyed as  
and the object hereof shall be fulfilled and the said Urquhart does hereby Covenant  
and agree that this Deed shall not be acted on or left than one year from  
the date hereof unless directed by the said Gray In witness whereof the
