respect that whereas Jeremiah Seymour stands justly indebted unto the said R. A. Urquhart
in the just and full sum of fifteen dollars lawful money of Virginia which will appear
by R. A. Urquhart's date with these presents and made payable from the date hereof and
the said Jeremiah Seymour being desirous to satisfy and secure the payment of the above
debt but more especially for the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by him the said
Bryant before the entering and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged Aliz that he the said Jeremiah Seymour hath granted bargain and
sold and doth by these presents grant bargain and sell to him the said Bryant his
heirs and assigns forever one bay mare two feather beds and furniture one cart and
wholes two sons and pig to him the said J. Pugh & Bryant his heirs and assigns forever
upon the following trust Aliz that if the said Jeremiah Seymour shall fail to pay
and discharge the above mentioned debt and all cost just arising to this trust it
shall be lawful and right in that event for him the said Pugh & Bryant to do as
as requested in writing from him the said R. A. Urquhart his heirs or assigns to let up &
sell for cash the above mentioned property after giving public notice by advertisement
in print at least ten days before the day of sale and out of the money so raised first
pay off the above debt and all costs just arising to this trust and the surplus if
