

May the 25<sup>th</sup> of this Indenture made and entered into this day of March 1831 Between George H Gray  
 & Nancy his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and James  
 Bell of the said County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in Consideration  
 of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars Current money of Virginia to the said George H  
 Gray in Hand by the said Bell at or before the concluding and delivery of these presents the  
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Gray has granted bargained and sold  
 and by these presents does grant, bargain and sell to the said Bell one Acre  
 tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the said County of Southampton adjoining the  
 lands of said Bell & Steve Briggs Simmons and others Mill tract and Celler tract and  
 bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a gum Corner of said Bell Richard H Simmons  
 and Collins tract thence along a new line of said land and Collins et al 111.126 p to the  
 middle of the Broad water Bridge road thence et al 80.688 p to ten degrees on the East  
 side of said road thence et 38 p 6.984 p to a dogwood Corner of said Bell & Alex  
 Briggs line thence 163 p 111. 19 p to a point in said Bell's line thence 5.32 101 p  
 to the Beginning Containing by a late Survey fifty three acres more or less. To have and  
 to hold the said above mentioned tract or parcel of Land together with all houses  
 and other appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the  
 said Bell his heirs or assigns forever to his and their only proper use and behoof found  
 and the said Gray for himself his heirs Executors administrators &c do hereby Consent  
 to and with the said Bell his heirs &c that he is the rightful owner of the said tract  
 or parcel of Land of will warrant and by these presents forever defend the right and title  
 to the said Land to him the said Bell his heirs and assigns any claim or demand
