This Indenture made this 18th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and thirty one Between Lewis & Branch the debtors of the first part Benjamin
Giffen Sonster of the second, part and Henry Lamon Creditor of the third part all of the
County of Southampton and State of Virginia Whereas the said Lewis & Branch is partly
indebted unto the said Henry Lamon in the sum of six hundred dollars by Bond
bearing date 22nd February 1831 with interest thereon till paid which the said
Lewis & Branch is willing and desirous to have over the said Lewis & Branch of the
sum for and in Consideration of the premises and also for the further sum of one dollar
of Lawful money of Virginia to the said Lewis & Branch or his heirs partly the
said Benjamin Giffen at or before the recording and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said Lewis & Branch has given granted
bargained and sold released and Conformed and by these presents do give grant bargain
and sell unto the said Benjamin Giffen his heirs and assigns one certain tract or
plantation or parcel of Land Containing by estimation one hundred and thirty acres
more or less by me and being situate in the County of Southampton State of Virginia
bounded by the lands of Robert Davis, Harriet Parmer, Charles C. Barnham
Martha Booth and Benjamin Travis being the land formerly belonged to
Thomas J. Davis thence belonging now any acre appertaining with the same
soil and curvilinear spaces and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof
to have and to hold the said bargained premises hereby conveyed unto the said
Benjamin Giffen his heirs Executors administrators and assigns so hereby remitted
and agreed to and with the said Lewis & Branch his heirs and assigns in manner
and form following that is to say that the said Lewis & Branch his heirs doth
and adme the aforesaid mentioned Land unto the said Benjamin Giffen his
heirs Exec & assigns against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and
forver defend by these presents upon Trust nevertheless that the said Benjamin
Giffen his heirs Executors and administrators shall pay unto the said Lewis & Branch
to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the within Land hereby conveyed
and take the profits thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment
of the sum of six hundred dollars wherein the whole or in part and upon the further
Trust that the said Benjamin Giffen his heirs and Exec & assigns shall and will so
soon after the happening of such default of payment as he his heirs Exec & assigns may
think proper or the said Henry Lamon his heirs Exec & assigns shall by just sale
the before mentioned Land to the highest bidder for ready money at public auction after
having fixed the time of sale at his own discretion and given ten days notice thereof
at the Court house door of this County and at many other places as he may think proper
or some Court day previous to the day of sale and out of the money arising from said
Land shall after satisfying the charges thereon and all other expenses attending the
Sale to pay the said Henry Lamon his heirs Exec & assigns the before mentioned sum of six
hundred dollars with lawful interest thereon and the balance if any pay unto the said
Lewis & Branch his heirs &c but if the whole of the aforesaid amount to sum shall be
paid off and discharged to the said Benjamin Giffen his heirs Exec & assigns on or before
the 25th February 1834 when the same is payable so that no default of payment be
made then this Indenture to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue in
Witness whereof the said Parties have hereunto set their hand and seals the date and
year above written
