This Indenture made this 4th day of April 1831 between Priscilla P Day of the County of Edge of Allright and State of Virginia of the one part and Edmund Turner of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia: Witnesseth that the said Priscilla P Day for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars to her in hand paid by the said Edmund Turner the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, conveyed and sold, and by these presents doth grant, convey and convey unto the said Edmund Turner his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land containing two hundred and thirty eight acres more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia as follows on the East by the land of Edmund Turner on the north by the land of Charles Poppe on the west by the land of Richard Blount on the south by the land of John Blount. It being the part of the land belonging to the estate of Henry Blount allotted to Priscilla P Day by the Commissioners under a decree of the Superior Court of Chancery in the City of Williamsburg To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land unto the said Edmund Turner his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Edmund Turner his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Priscilla P Day for herself her heirs executors and administrators doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Edmund Turner his heirs and assigns that she the said Priscilla P Day and her heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances unto him the said Edmund Turner his heirs and assigns against her the said Priscilla P Day and her heirs and against all persons whomsoever shall and will by these presents forever warrant and defend. In witness whereof the said Priscilla P Day has hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal the day and year above written.
